NOTICE is given that Bath and North East Somerset Council proposes to exercise its powers conferred by section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, for the installation of a raised pedestrian zebra crossing in the road as specified in the Schedule 1 of this Notice.

NOTICE is given that Bath and North East Somerset Council proposes to exercise its powers conferred by The Highways Act 1980 Section 90A, which permits a highway authority to both construct and remove road humps in a public road, for which they are the highway authority, if the highway is subject to a legal speed limit for motor vehicles of 30 miles per hour or less or the road humps are specially authorised by the Secretary of State.
