Traffic Management (Bath and North East Somerset Council)

Permit Scheme Variation Order 2020

Made 29th October 2020

Coming into force 1st December 2020

The Traffic Management (Bath and North East Somerset Council) Permit Scheme Order 2020 was made on the 5th March 2020 and came into force on 1st May 2020. That order gave effect to the Bath and North East Somerset Permit Scheme. The Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Council") now wishes to amend the Bath and North East Somerset Permit Scheme as set out in this variation order.

Now, by this variation order, the Council in exercise of its powers conferred by Section 36(1) and Section 36(3) of the Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the 2004 Act") and acting as the Local Highway Authority varies the Bath and North East Somerset Permit Scheme as set out below.

1. The Bath and North East Somerset Permit Scheme is contained in Schedule 1 to the Traffic Management (Bath and North East Somerset Council) Permit Scheme Order. By this variation order, all the words of Schedule 1 to the Traffic Management (Bath and North East Somerset Council) Permit Scheme Order are deleted and replaced with the words of Schedule 1 to this variation order.
2. This variation order comes into force on the 1st December 2020 and may be cited as the "Traffic Management (Bath and North East Somerset Council) Permit Scheme Variation Order 2020".
3. The Bath and North East Somerset Council Permit Scheme as varied by this order complies with the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) Regulations 2007, as amended by the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2015.
4. The Bath and North East Somerset Council Permit Scheme as varied by this order complies with all other related primary and secondary legislation in relation to Traffic Management Permit Schemes and does not exceed those powers under such legislation.
5. Part 8 of the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) Regulations 2007, as amended by the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2015, shall apply to the specified streets within the Bath and North East Somerset Council Permit Scheme.
