INITIAL ALLOCATION STATEMENT FOR FARMBOROUGH CHURCH PRIMARY SCHOOL

PLACES AVAILABLE: 29

As Farmborough Church Primary School was oversubscribed it was necessary to use Bath & North East Somerset's admissions criteria, as published in 'A Primary School for Your Child – 2020/21', to allocate the places available at the school. Applications for all schools are considered under an equal preference system which means that all preferences (1st, 2nd & 3rd) for each school are considered equally. If there are any cases where more than one of the school preferences named on the application form could have been met only the highest preference school has been allocated.

A total of **58 preferences** were originally received for Farmborough C of E Primary School which has a published Admission Number of **25** but the Academy Trust has decided to work to a higher Admission Number of **29** for 2020-21.

If, under any of the categories listed, places were offered and refused, priority was given to those who live closest to the school as measured in a direct line between the home address and the school.

How the initial allocation of places was made for this particular school:

- 1 place has been offered to a child with a Statement of Special Educational Needs or Education, Health and Care Plan where the school has been named in their statement. This child is included within the Admission Number for the school.
- **0 Category A Applicants** Looked after children or previously looked after children
- **10 Category B Applicants** ie Children who will have a sibling in attendance on the admission date at the preferred school and they either
 - live within a 1.5 mile radius* of the school; or
 - live outside a 1.5 mile radius* of the school but their sibling was offered a place prior to September 2013; or
 - live outside a 1.5 mile radius* of the school but it is their closest Community or Voluntary Controlled School
- *The 1.5 mile radius is measured from the address point of the school as defined by the Local Land & Property Gazetter (LLPG)
- 18 Category C Applicants Children who live closest to the school as measured in a direct line. The furthest direct line distance between the preferred school and the home address offered in this category was 2.314 miles.
- 8 children in total has initially been refused a place at Farmborough C of E Primary School. (All other preferences originally considered have qualified for another school as a higher preference)

Position as at 01 June 2020 following the initial allocations on 16 April 2020

Following the initial allocations on 16 April 2020, no further places have become available.

4 parents originally refused a place opted to lodge an appeal, 1 child went on the waiting list and 2 late applications were received.
