INITIAL ALLOCATION STATEMENT FOR SHOSCOMBE C of E PRIMARY SCHOOL

PLACES AVAILABLE: 20

As Shoscombe C of E Primary School was oversubscribed it was necessary to use the admissions criteria, as published in 'A Primary School for Your Child – 2020/21', to allocate the places available at the school. Applications for all schools are considered under an equal preference system which means that all preferences (1st, 2nd & 3rd) for each school are considered equally. If there are any cases where more than one of the school preferences named on the application form could have been met only the highest preference school has been allocated.

A total of **36 preferences** were originally received for Shoscombe C of E Primary School which has a published Admission Number of **17** but the Academy Trust has decided to work to a higher Admission Number of **20** for 2020-21.

If, under any of the categories listed, places were offered and refused, priority was given to those who live closest to the school as measured in a direct line between the home address and the school.

How the initial allocation of places was made for this particular school:

0 Category 1 Applicants - Looked after children or previously looked after children

6 Category 2 Applicants – Children who at the time of application have an older sibling at the school who will still be on roll at the time of admission and who live at the same address.

1 Category 3 Applicants – Children who at the time of application are eligible to receive a Pupil Premium or a Service Premium grant.

0 Category 4 Applicants - Children of permanent members of staff.

13 Category 5 Applicants - Children not satisfying a higher criterion. **The furthest direct line distance between the preferred school and the home address offered in this category was 2.141 miles.**

1 child in total has initially been refused a place at Shoscombe C of E Primary School. (All other preferences originally considered have qualified for another school as a higher preference)
