

BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL

(BYWAY OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC CL23/41, BURLEDGE) (5 FEET WIDTH RESTRICTION) (PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES) ORDER 2012

NOTICE is given that on 23rd October 2012 the Bath and North East Somerset Council made the following order under provisions contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will restrict vehicles on **Byway Open to All Traffic CL23/41, Burledge**. The restrictions will:

- (1) Prohibit any vehicle exceeding 5 feet in width from proceeding in a length of the Byway; and
- (2) Prohibit motor vehicles on parts of the Byway.

The Bath and North East Somerset Council (Byway Open to All Traffic CL23/41, Burledge) (5 Feet Width Restriction) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Order 2012 will come into operation on 27th November 2012 and a copy, together with a map and a Statement of the Council's Reasons for making the order may be inspected at The One Stop Shop, The Hollies, Midsomer Norton and at the offices below during normal office hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of, or any provision contained in the order on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any of the relevant requirements of that Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, may within six weeks after the date on which the order was made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
