

NOTICE OF EMERGENCY PATH CLOSURE

SECTION 14 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS ACT 1984

BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PROWTC004, PUBLIC FOOTPATH BA12/12, THE TYNING, FRESHFORD) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF USE BY PEDESTRIANS) ORDER 2019

Notice is given that Bath and North East Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has temporarily introduced a path closure to that length of public footpath BA12/12 commencing from a junction with public footpaths BA12/12 and BA12/9 at grid reference ST 7886 5997 and proceeding in a generally southwesterly direction for approximately 430 metres to a junction with Rosemary Lane at grid reference ST 7869 5967.


This path closure is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public; namely, the danger caused by a number of fallen trees and trees which are in danger of falling. The Order came into force on 12th March 2019 and will be effective for 21 days.
