(PUBLIC FOOTPATH BA12/33, FRESHFORD CROSSING, FRESHFORD)
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2022**

Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Council") being the highway authority for Public Footpath BA12/33, Freshford Crossing, Freshford in the County and District of Bath and North East Somerset is satisfied that pedestrian traffic over the said footpath should be restricted because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the rights of way; namely, Sunbelt Rentals on behalf of Network Rail are proposing to carry out crossing upgrade works to allow for safer use of the crossing.

The Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following order:

1. No person shall proceed over the section of Public Footpath BA12/33 commencing from grid reference ST 7911 6036 (point A on the order map) and continuing in a generally northeasterly direction for approximately 17 metres to grid reference ST 7912 6037 (point B on the order map).
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any contractor necessarily proceeding to or from the said works.
3. This order shall come into operation on 18th July 2022 and will be operative for a period of 5 days. The closure will only be effective during that period when signs stating 'Footpath Closed' are in place on site. The Order may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council (Public Footpath BA12/33, Freshford Crossing, Freshford) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2022.
