THE BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATHS BA9/3, CORSTON AND BA17/1 AND BA17/2 NEWTON ST LOE) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2020

Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Council") being the highway authority for public footpaths BA9/3, Corston and BA17/1 and BA17/2, Newton St Loe in the County and District of Bath and North East Somerset is satisfied that pedestrian traffic in the said public footpaths should be restricted because of the likelihood of danger to the public; namely heavy plant/vehicle movements associated with remedial embankment works on behalf of Network Rail.

The Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following order:

- 1. No person shall proceed in the full lengths of Public Footpaths:
 - a) BA9/3, Corston commencing from a junction with A4 Bristol Road at grid reference ST 6969 6581 (Point A on the Order Map) and proceeding in a generally northeasterly direction for approximately 197 metres to a junction with Public Footpaths BA9/4 and BA9/5 at grid reference ST 6919 6598 (Point B on the Order Map)
 - b) BA17/1, Newton St Loe commencing from a junction with A4 Bristol Road at grid reference ST 7017 6532 (point C on the Order Map) and proceeding in a generally northeasterly direction for approximately 394 metres to a junction with Public Footpath BA17/3 at grid reference ST 7033 6569 (point D on the Order Map) and
 - c) BA17/2, Newton St Loe commencing from a junction with A4 Bristol Road at grid reference ST 6992 6557 (point E on the Order Map) and proceeding in a generally northeasterly direction for approximately 161 metres and turning in a generally easterly direction for approximately 314 metres to a junction with Public Footpath BA17/1 at grid reference ST 7031 6564 (point F on the Order Map).
- 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any contractor necessarily proceeding to or from the said works.
- 3. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any pedestrian requiring access to any premises situated on or adjacent to the public footpaths, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from and only from the public footpaths:

4. This order shall come into operation on 11th September 2020 and will be operative for a period of 6 months. The closure will only be effective during that period when signs stating 'Footpath Closed' are in place on site. The Order may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council (Public Footpaths BA9/3, Corston and BA17/1 and BA17/2, Newton St Loe) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2020.


