

NOTICE OF ORDER
SECTION 14 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATHS BA27/47, SALTFFORD,
BA9/4 AND BA9/5, CORSTON AND BA17/3 NEWTON ST LOE) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC
REGULATION ORDER 2020

Notice is given that Bath and North East Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has made an order, the effect of which is to temporarily introduce a path closure to the lengths of public footpaths from grid reference ST 6900 6664 (point A on the attached Plan) in a southeasterly direction via points B and C to grid reference ST 7040 6589 (point D), namely BA27/47 from Saltford Rowing Club to its junction with public footpath BA9/5; the full lengths of BA9/5 and BA9/4; and BA17/3 from its junction with BA9/4 to the point where it passes underneath the Bristol and Bath Railway Path Cycle Track.

This order is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the rights of way; namely, Network Rail are proposing to carry out remedial embankment works. The Order comes into force on 3rd August 2020 and will be effective for a maximum period of 6 months. The restriction may not be in effect for the whole of the period but only for so long as is necessary to execute the works and will only be effective during that period when signs stating 'Path Closed' are in place. This is anticipated to be from **14th September 2020** for **4½ months**.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTE – points A-E-H-D on the attached plan – Public Footpath BA27/47, The Shallows, A4 Bath Road, Public Footpath BA17/3 and Vice Versa.
