**BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATHS
BA27/47, SALTFORD, BA9/4 AND BA9/5, CORSTON AND BA17/3 NEWTON ST
LOE) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2020**

Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Council") being the highway authority for public footpaths BA27/47, Saltford, BA9/4 and BA9/5, Corston and BA17/3, Newton St Loe in the County and District of Bath and North East Somerset is satisfied that pedestrian traffic in the said public footpaths should be restricted because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road to facilitate remedial embankment works on behalf of the Network Rail.

The Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following order:

1. No person shall proceed in that length of public footpath BA27/47, Saltford, from grid reference ST 6900 6664 at Saltford Rowing Club (point A on the attached Order Map) in a southeasterly direction to its junction with public footpath BA9/4; the full lengths of public footpaths BA9/5 and BA9/4, Corston and public footpath BA17/3, Newton St Loe from its junction with public footpath BA9/4 continuing in a southeasterly direction to the point where it passes underneath the Bristol and Bath Railway Path Cycle Track at grid reference ST 7040 6589 (point D on the attached Order Map).
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any contractor necessarily proceeding to or from the said works.
3. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any pedestrian requiring access to any premises situated on or adjacent to the public footpaths, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from, the public footpaths.
4. This order shall come into operation on 3rd August 2020 and will be operative for a period of 6 months. The closure will only be effective during that period when signs stating 'Path Closed' are in place on site. The Order may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council (Public Footpaths BA27/47, Saltford; BA9/4 and BA9/5, Corston and BA17/3 Newton St Loe) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2020.

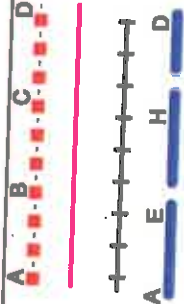
