

NOTICE OF MAKING OF ORDER
SECTION 14 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL
(PUBLIC FOOTPATHS BA16/1 AND BA16/3, TUCKING MILL, MONKTON COMBE)
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2021

Notice is given that Bath and North East Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has made an order the effect of which will be to temporarily introduce a path closure to:

- the section of Public Footpath (FP) BA16/1 commencing from grid reference ST 7655 6159 (point A on the closure map) and continuing in a generally north westerly direction for approximately 230 metres to grid reference ST 7638 6173 (point B); and
- the section of FP BA16/3 commencing from grid reference ST 7614 6163 (point C) and continuing in a generally north easterly direction for approximately 230 metres to the junction with FP BA16/2 at grid reference ST 7633 6173 (point D).

This order is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the rights of way; namely, Wessex Water are proposing woodland management works relating to ash dieback within the woodland. The Order will come into force on **13th September 2021** and will be effective for **six months**. The closure will only be effective during the period when signs stating 'Footpath Closed' are in place on site and only for so long as is necessary to execute the works.
