BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC BRIDLEWAY CL24/125, RADSTOCK SEWAGE WORKS, RADSTOCK) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2024

Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Council") being the highway authority for Public Bridleway CL24/125, Radstock, in the County and District of Bath and North East Somerset is satisfied that all traffic over the said bridleway should be restricted because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the right of way; namely, Wessex Water Services Ltd are proposing to carry out additional treatment installation works.

The Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following order:

- 1. No person shall proceed over the full length of Public Bridleway CL24/125, Radstock commencing from a junction with Mill Road and Public Bridleway CL24/123 at grid reference ST 6989 5510 (point A on the order map) and proceeding in a generally north northwesterly direction for approximately 150 metres to a junction with Whitelands Hill and Public Footpath CL24/114 at grid reference ST 6982 5522 (point B on the order map).
- 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any contractor necessarily proceeding to or from the said works.
- 3. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any pedestrian requiring access to any premises situated on or adjacent to the public path, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from, the public path.
- 4. This order shall come into operation on 25th March 2024 and will be operative until 5th April 2024. The closure will only be effective during that period when signs stating 'Bridleway Closed' are in place on site. The Order may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council (Public Bridleway CL24/125, Radstock Sewage Works, Radstock) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2024.
