
Bath and North East Somerset Council are proposing to change the Public Rights of Way network in respect of **Public Footpath BA27/31 at Broadmead Roundabout, Bath Road, Keynsham**


The general effect of the proposals is shown on the consultation plan. A section of Public Footpath BA27/31 commencing at grid reference ST 6662 6829 in a generally southerly direction for approximately 42 metres and continuing for approximately 14 metres to grid reference ST 6662 6823 would be stopped up, as shown on the attached plan by a continuous red line between points A-B-C. The new line of the FP would commence from grid reference ST 6662 6829 in a generally west southwesterly direction for approximately 33 metres to ST 6659 6828 then turning in a generally south easterly direction for approximately 61 metres to grid reference ST 6662 6823, as shown on the plan by a continuous green line between points A-D-C.

The changes would be achieved by way of a diversion order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ('the Act'). These changes are proposed in the interests of the landowner in order to route the FP away from the industrial buildings and yard and onto a route which will border the site through a woodland area.
