The above Order made on 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2018, has been confirmed by Bath and North East Somerset Council without modification.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by

- adding to them the footpath commencing from grid reference ST 7842 6694 and proceeding in a generally NE direction adjacent to the railway for approximately 79m to grid reference ST 7847 6699 and turning in a generally ENE direction for approximately 39m midway across the railway bridge over the River Avon to the Bathampton/Bathford parish boundary at grid reference ST 7851 6701 and continuing in a generally ENE direction for approximately 39m across the remainder of the bridge to grid reference ST 7854 6703 and turning in a generally E direction adjacent to the railway for approximately 55m to a junction with Bradford Road (A363) at grid reference ST 7860 6704;
- and varying the particulars relating to the footpath commencing from a junction with Tyning Road at grid reference ST 7820 6661 and proceeding in a generally NE direction over a railway level-crossing for approximately 15m to grid reference ST 7821 6662 and continuing in a generally NE direction across fields for approximately 382m to grid reference ST 7842 6694.
