

NOTICE OF EXTENSION OF ORDER

SECTION 14 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATHS BA27/47, SALTFFORD, BA9/4 AND BA9/5, CORSTON AND BA17/3 NEWTON ST LOE) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2020

Notice is given that the above order made by Bath and North East Somerset Council on 27th July 2020 will continue in force with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport in exercise of his powers under section 15(5) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 until the works to which it relates have been completed or until 2nd February 2022 whichever is the earlier. The effect of the extension is to continue to close the section of public footpath from grid reference ST 6900 6664 in a southeasterly direction to grid reference ST 7040 6589, namely BA27/47 from Saltford Rowing Club to its junction with public footpath BA9/5; the full lengths of BA9/5 and BA9/4; and BA17/3 from its junction with BA9/4 to the point where it passes underneath the Bristol and Bath Railway Path Cycle Track.

This order is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the right of way; namely, Graham Construction on behalf of Network Rail are continuing carrying out remedial embankment works. The Order will continue in force until **2nd February 2022**.
