NOTICE OF MAKING OF THE ORDER SECTION 14 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH CL4/29A, BREACH HILL LANE, CHEW STOKE) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2022

Notice is given that Bath and North East Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has made an order, the effect of which extends a closure by notice introducing a temporary closure to the section of public footpath CL4/29a, Chew Stoke from its junction with Breach Hill Lane at grid reference ST 5579 6124 in a generally northerly direction for approximately 42 metres to a field boundary at grid reference ST 5577 6127, as shown on the closure map.

This order is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public, or of serious damage to the right of way; namely danger from instability of an adjoining wall; and works proposed to be executed on or near the right of way, namely, subsequent remedial repair works. The Order will come into force on 27th January 2022 and will be effective until 6th July 2022. The closure will only be operative during the period when signs stating 'Footpath Closed' are in place on site and only for so long as there is a danger or as is necessary to execute the works.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTE: Public Footpath CL4/29a, Public Bridleway CL4/31 (Scornfield Lane), Breach Hill Lane and Vice Versa.
