

NOTICE OF EXTENSION OF ORDER

SECTION 14 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATHS BA27/69 AND 48, SALT FORD MEADS, SALT FORD) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023

Notice is given that the Secretary of State for Transport in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has extended the duration of the above named order which has the effect of temporarily closing the section of public footpath BA27/69 from a junction with BA27/41 at grid reference ST 6912 6887 and proceeding in a generally easterly direction for approximately 30 metres to a junction with BA27/48 at grid reference ST 6915 68888 and the section of public footpath BA27/48 from a junction with BA27/69 at grid reference ST 6915 68888 and proceeding in a generally southerly direction for approximately 1170 metres to a junction with Mead Lane at grid reference .

This order is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the right of way; namely, Wessex Water are constructing a new bridge and road to Salford Water Recycling Centre. The Order was originally effective until 10th October 2023 and has been extended until 2nd February 2024.

Public footpath BA27/41 – Avon Lane – Mead Lane. Vice Versa.

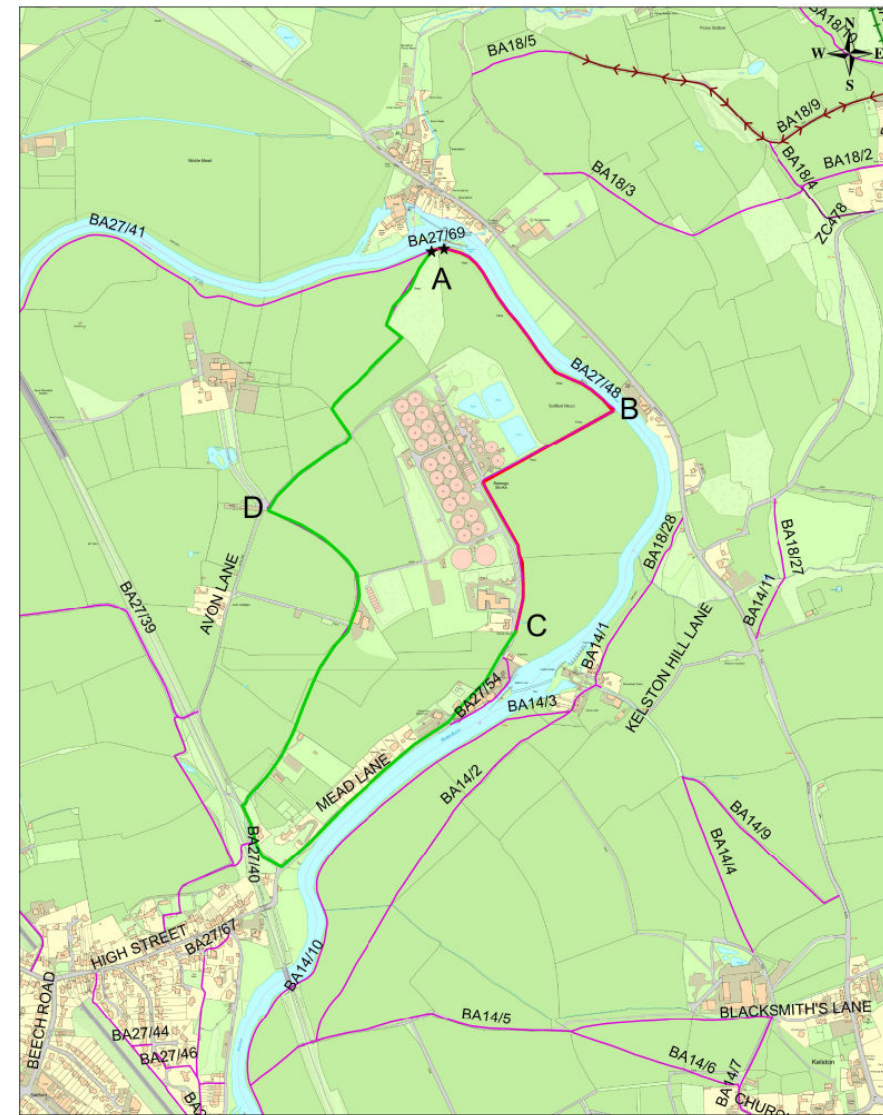
