Notice is given that Bath and North East Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 intends to make an order the effect of which will be to temporarily introduce a path closure to a section of Public Footpath BA27/30, Keynsham, commencing from grid reference ST 6673 6734 (point A on the order map) and continuing in a generally north northwesterly direction for approximately 330 metres to grid reference ST 6657 6763 (point B on the order map).

This order is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the footpath; namely, Bath and North East Somerset Council are proposing pathway and access improvement works.

The Order will come into force on 5<sup>th</sup> April 2024 and will be effective for **FOUR MONTHS**. The closure will only be effective during the period when signs stating 'Footpath Closed' are in place on site and only for so long as is necessary to execute the works. This is expected to be for **2 WEEKS**.


