**BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL
(BYWAY OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC BA25/38, UPPER HAYES, WELLOW)
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023**

Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Council") being the highway authority for Byway Open to All Traffic BA25/38 in the County and District of Bath and North East Somerset is satisfied that all traffic in the said byway should be restricted because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road to facilitate new service connection works on behalf of the Bristol Water.

The Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following order:

1. No person or vehicle shall proceed in that length of BOAT BA25/38 commencing from its junction with Bath Hill at grid reference ST 7342 5887 for approximately 100 metres in a generally southwesterly direction to grid reference ST 7332 5883.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any contractor necessarily proceeding to or from the said works.
3. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any pedestrian requiring access to any premises situated on or adjacent to the byway, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from, the byway.
4. This order shall come into operation on 7th August 2023 and will be operative for a period of ONE week. The closure will only be effective during that period when signs stating 'Footpath Closed' are in place at either end of the affected section of byway. The Order may be cited as the Bath And North East Somerset Council (Byway Open To All Traffic BA25/38, Upper Hayes, Wellow) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2023.
