
## FOR THE ATTENTION OF ALL PUBLIC FOOTPATH USERS



Bath and North East Somerset Council are proposing to change the Public Rights of Way network at Somerdale, Keynsham Hams, Keynsham



Bath and North East Somerset Council are consulting on a proposal to create a public footpath running from a junction with Dryleaze, Keynsham (point A on the above plan) in a generally north westerly direction for approximately 664 metres to point B, running over an already tarmacked path. The footpath would then turn in a generally westerly direction for approximately 664 metres, across a new bridge at point C, to a junction with Durley Lane at point D. The surface of this section will remain unsurfaced. The proposed route is shown on the above plan by a dashed green line. The legal width of the path would be 3 metres from point A to B and 2 metres from point B to D.
