
FOR THE ATTENTION OF ALL PUBLIC FOOTPATH USERS

Bath & North East Somerset Council

Bath and North East Somerset Council are proposing to change the Public Rights of Way network in respect of public footpath BA22/7 in the Parish of **South Stoke**



The general effect of the proposal is shown on the above Plan. Public Footpath BA22/7 commencing from its junction with Packhorse Lane at point A on the plan continuing in a generally north easterly direction for approximately 167 metres to a junction with Old Midford Road at point B would be stopped up, as shown on the plan by a bold continuous line. The new line of FP BA22/7 would commence from point A continuing in a generally northerly direction for approximately 188 metres to a junction with Midford Road (B3110) at point C, as shown on the plan by a bold broken line.

The change is proposed by the landowner in the interests of the public to improve visibility when crossing B3110 Midford Road, in order to continue following FP BA22/8 or vice versa. The proposal is supported by the local Councillor, Parish Council and B&NES Traffic Management. The change would be achieved by way of a diversion order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the Act"). A kissing gate would be authorised under section 147 of the Act at point C to prevent the ingress and egress of livestock.
