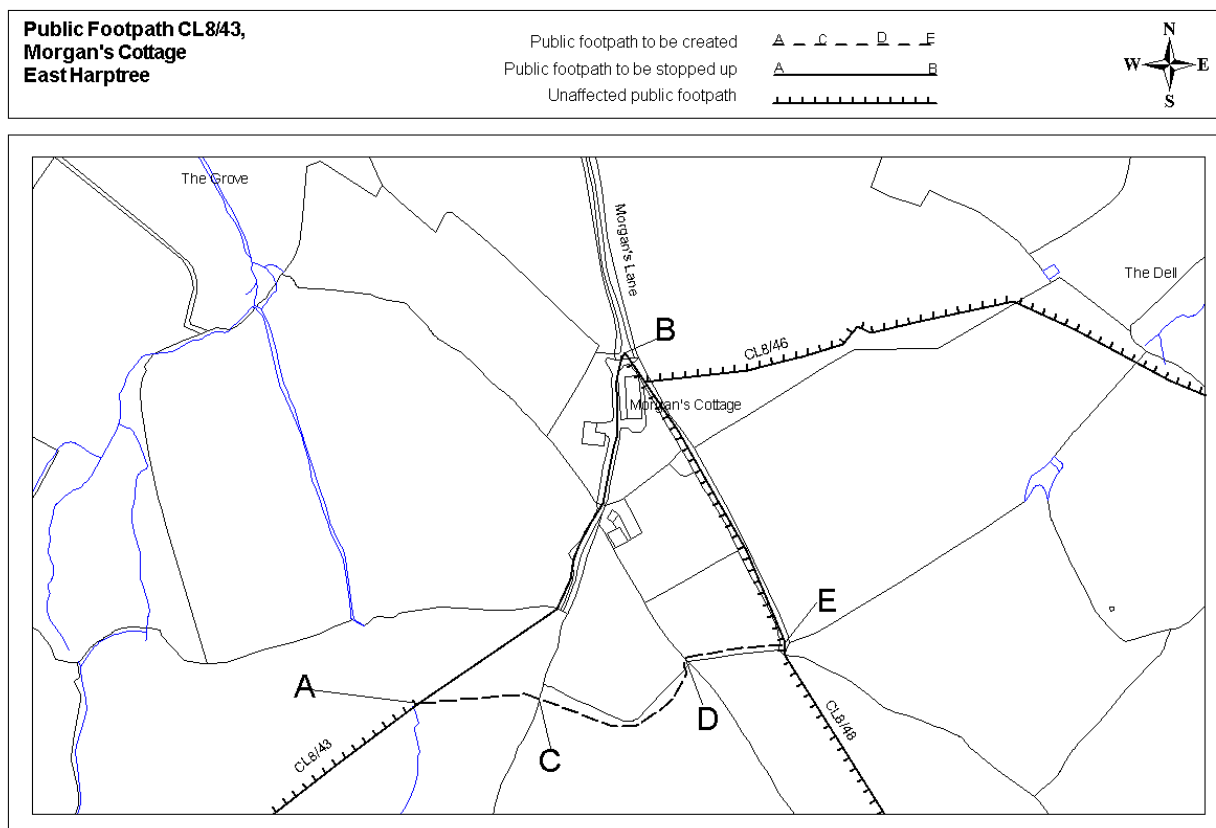


FOR THE ATTENTION OF ALL PUBLIC FOOTPATH USERS

Bath and North East Somerset Council are proposing to change the Public Rights of Way network in respect of public footpath CL8/43 at Morgan's Cottage, Morgan's Lane in the Parish of **East Harptree**



The general effect of the proposal is shown on the attached Plan. A section of Public Footpath CL8/43 commencing from point A on the plan proceeding in a generally northeasterly direction for approximately 250 metres to a junction with FP CL8/48 at point B would be stopped up, as shown on the plan by a bold continuous line.

The new line of FP CL8/43 would commence from point A proceeding in a generally easterly direction for approximately 232 metres via points C and D to a junction with FP CL8/48 at point E as shown on the plan by a bold broken line.

These changes are proposed in the interests of the landowner as they would remove the footpath from the vicinity of the house and garden and thereby improve privacy. The proposed route will run over a grassy surface which will be safer to traverse as the current route proceeds down a track with a loose stone bed which is frequently waterlogged, often with running water. The changes would be achieved by way of a diversion order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the Act"). Kissing gates would be authorised under section 147 of the Act at points C, D and E to prevent the ingress and egress of livestock.
