The effect of the order as confirmed is to divert the section of public footpath running from grid reference ST 5662 5448 (point A on the Order Map) and proceeding in a generally north-northeasterly direction for approximately 248 metres to a junction with Public Footpath CL8/48 and Morgan's Lane at grid reference ST 5674 5468 (point B on the order map) to a new line running from grid reference ST 5662 5448 (point A on the Order Map) and proceeding in a generally easterly direction for approximately 213 metres to a junction with Public Footpath CL8/48 at grid reference ST 5683 5452 (point C on the order map) as shown on the order map.

The order came into force on 24th January 2019 but if any person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from the date of this notice, make an application to the High Court.
