BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH BA27/30, MANOR ROAD WOODLAND, KEYNSHAM) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2024

Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Council") being the highway authority for Public Footpath BA27/30, Keynsham in the County and District of Bath and North East Somerset is satisfied that pedestrian traffic in the said footpath should be restricted because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road to facilitate pathway and access improvement works on behalf of Bath and North East Somerset Council.

The Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following order:

- 1. No person shall proceed in that length of Public Footpath BA27/30, Keynsham, commencing from grid reference ST 6673 6734 (point A on the order map) and continuing in a generally north northwesterly direction for approximately 330 metres to grid reference ST 6657 6763 (point B on the order map).
- 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any contractor necessarily proceeding to or from the said works.
- 3. This order shall come into operation on 5th April 2024 and will be operative for a period of 4 months. The closure will only be effective during that period when signs stating 'Footpath Closed' are in place on site. The Order may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council (Public Footpath BA27/30, Manor Road Woodland, Keynsham) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2024.
