Notice is given that Bath and North East Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has temporarily introduced a path closure with immediate effect to that length of public footpath BA12/12 commencing from a junction with public footpaths BA12/11 and BA12/9 at grid reference ST 7886 5997 (Point A on the Notice Plan) and proceeding in a generally southwesterly direction for approximately 430 metres to a junction with Rosemary Lane at grid reference ST 7869 5967 (Point B on the Notice Plan).

This temporary closure is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public: namely, the danger caused by the eroded surface of the footpath which requires repair before it can once again be used safely. The closure has come into force with immediate effect and will be effective for 21 days.
