

CLOSURE BY NOTICE

SECTION 14(2) OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL

PUBLIC FOOTPATH BA12/16, ROSEMARY LANE, FRESHFORD

Notice is given that Bath and North East Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has temporarily introduced a path closure with immediate effect to that length of public footpath BA12/16 commencing from a junction with Rosemary Lane at grid reference ST 7830 5964 (Point A on the Notice Plan) and proceeding in a generally northeasterly direction for approximately 152 metres to a junction with Public Footpaths BA12/17 & BA12/18 at grid reference ST 7842 5973 (Point B on the Notice Plan).



This temporary closure is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public: namely, the danger caused by a collapsed retaining wall, underneath the footpath. The closure has come into force with immediate effect and will be effective for 21 days.
