

NOTICE OF MAKING OF ORDER

SECTION 14 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS ACT 1984

BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH BC33/8, IVY AVENUE, BATH) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2024

Notice is given that Bath and North East Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has made an order to temporarily introduce a closure to the section of public footpath BC33/8 commencing from Ivy Avenue at grid reference ST 7316 6362 (point A on the Notice Plan) and proceeding in a generally east-southeasterly direction for approximately 47 metres to the top of the flight of steps at grid reference ST 7320 6360 (point B on the Notice Plan).

This order is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the right of way: namely, Bath & North East Somerset Council are carrying out tarmacking and refurbishment works. The Order will come into force on 5 February 2024 and will be effective for **four weeks**. The restriction may not be effected for the whole of the period but only for so long as is necessary to execute the works. This is anticipated to be for **one week**.
