

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO MAKE ORDER
SECTION 14 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL
(PUBLIC FOOTPATH CL24/84, WATERLOO ROAD, RASTOCK)
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2021


Notice is given that Bath and North East Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 intends to make an order the effect of which will be to temporarily introduce a path closure to the full length of Public Footpath CL24/84, Radstock, from its junction with Waterloo Road to its junction with Waldegrave Terrace.

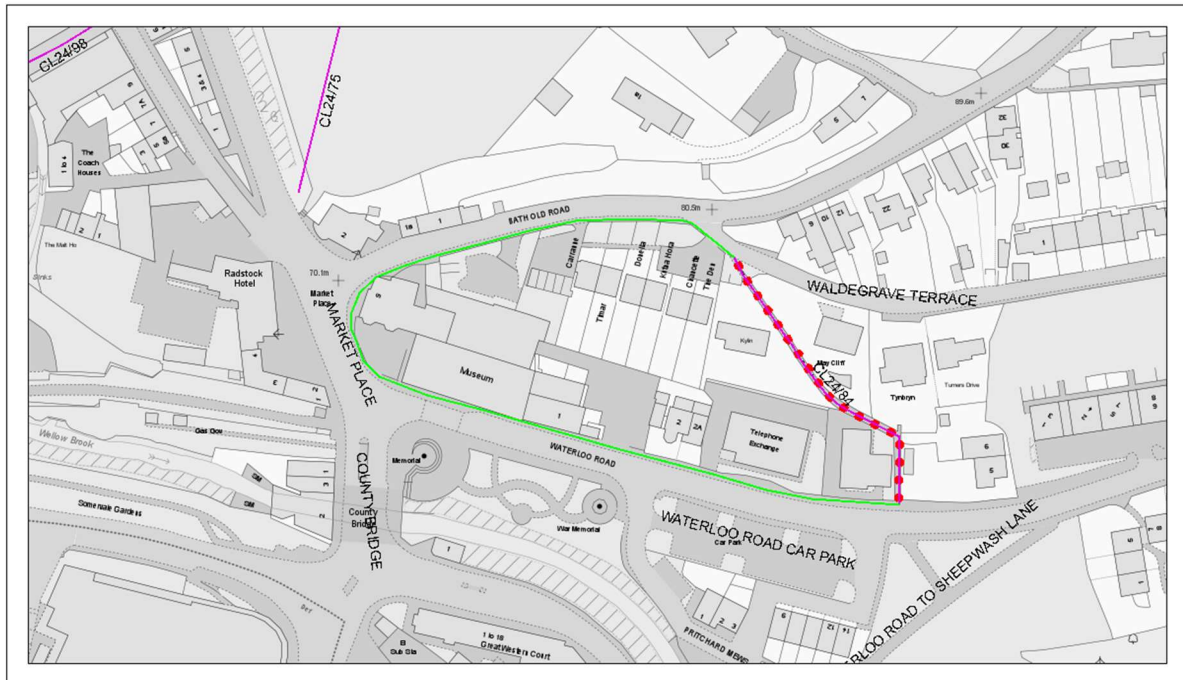
This order is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the right of way; namely, Western Power Distribution are proposing electrical supply works to Hope House Centre, Radstock. The Order will come into force on 22nd March 2021 and will be effective for a maximum period of two weeks. The closure will only be effective during the period when signs stating 'Footpath Closed' are in place on site and only for so long as is necessary to execute the works. This is anticipated to be for **ONE WEEK**.
