

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2018

On 18th October 2018, Bath and North East Somerset Council confirmed the above order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to divert the public footpath running from grid reference ST 7286 6937 (point A on the Order Map) and proceeding in a generally west-northwesterly direction for approximately 178 metres to grid reference ST 7271 6946 (point C on the Order Map) to a new line running from grid reference ST 7286 6937 (point A on the Order Map) and proceeding in a generally north-northeasterly direction for approximately 84 metres to grid reference ST 7290 6944 (point B on the Order Map) and turning in a generally westerly direction for approximately 203 metres to grid reference ST 7271 6946 (point C on the Order Map), as shown on the order map.

A copy of the order as confirmed and the order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at The One Stop Shop, 3-4 Manvers Street, Bath during normal office hours. The order came into force on 25th October 2018 but if any person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from the date of this notice, make an application to the High Court.
