On 3rd September 2020 the Bath and North East Somerset Council confirmed the above order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to divert that section of the public bridleway running from grid reference ST 7285 5819 (point A on the order map) and proceeding in a generally westerly direction for approximately 375 metres to a junction with Byway Open to All Traffic BA25/38 at grid reference ST 7248 5824 (point B on the order map) to a line running from grid reference ST 7285 5819 (point A on the order map) and proceeding in a generally northwesterly direction for approximately 185 metres to grid reference ST 7274 5834 (point C on the order map), as shown on the order map.

The order came into force on 3rd September 2020 but if any person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from the date of this notice, make an application to the High Court.
