## BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH BA2/5, RIVERPATH, BATHEASTON) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023

Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Council") being the highway authority for Public Footpath BA2/5, Batheaston in the County and District of Bath and North East Somerset is satisfied that pedestrian traffic in the said public footpath should be restricted because of the likelihood of danger to the public, or of serious damage to the road; namely, the riverbank has been undermined by river erosion.

The Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following order:

- No person shall proceed in the section of public footpath BA2/5 commencing from a junction with public footpaths BA2/3 and BA2/4 at ST 7747 6706 (Point A) and proceeding in a generally north easterly direction along the riverpath for approximately 610 metres to grid reference ST 7795 6738 (Point B).
- 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any contractor necessarily proceeding to or from the said works.
- 3. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any pedestrian requiring access to any premises situated on or adjacent to the public footpath, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from, the public footpath.
- 4. This order shall come into operation on 14<sup>th</sup> December 2023 and will be operative for a period of six months weeks unless revoked earlier.
- 5. The Order may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council (Public Footpath BA2/5, Riverpath Batheaston) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2023.


