
Bath & North East Somerset Council

The Order has been made to divert a section of public bridleway BA25/16, which is generally only used by walkers, onto the route which is currently used by horseriders (as shown by a bold broken line on the indicative map). A dedication of highway agreement has been signed by Wellow Parish Council and the Landowners in order to create a public footpath on the current route of this section of public bridleway BA25/19, which will come into effect if and when the diversion of the public bridleway comes into effect. The existing bridleway route (shown by a bold continuous line on the indicative map) will always therefore be available for use by walkers.
