
PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY CONSULTATION

Bath and North East Somerset Council are proposing to make alterations to the the Public Rights of Way network at the south of Keynsham

Bath and North East Somerset Council are consulting on a proposal to create a public footpath running from a junction with Giffords Lane at Point G on the below plan in a generally east-north-easterly direction for approximately 50 metres to a junction with St Clements Road at Point H; this route is shown by a broken green line on the plan below. The legal width of the path would be 2 metres throughout and the new path would be created without any limitations.

The route is already used by members of the public; however, the Council does not have any evidence that the route currently carried any public rights. The proposal is therefore intended to create public rights to ensure that pedestrians can continue to use the route.
