Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Orders have been submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for determination. An Inspector will be appointed by the Secretary of State to determine the Orders.

The **start date** for the above Order is **16 February 2021**

Consideration of the Orders will take the form of exchanges of statements of case and comments on statements of case.

1.The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to create the public footpaths (FPs): FP BA5/61 From a junction with Lansdown Lane at grid reference ST 7269 6824 (point S on the Order Map) and proceeding in a generally NNW direction for approx 6m to a junction with FP BA5/65 at ST 7269 6825 (point T) and turning in a generally NNE direction for approx 154m to ST 7275 6838 (point U) and turning in a generally NNW direction for approx 100m to a junction with FP BA5/66 at ST 7273 6847 (point V) and turning in a generally WNW direction for approx 151m to a junction with FP BA5/35 at ST 7261 6856 (point G); FP BA5/62 From a junction with FP BA5/36 at ST 7191 6891 (point H) and proceeding in a generally WNW direction for approx 113m to a junction with FP BA5/63 at ST 7181 6897 (point K); FP BA5/63 From a junction with FP BA5/43 at ST 7182 6898 (point J) and proceeding in a generally SW direction for approx 14m to a junction with FP BA5/62 at ST 7181 6897 (point K) and turning in a generally W direction for approx 61m to a junction with FP BA18/29 at ST 7175 6896 (point L); FP BA18/29 From a junction with FP BA5/63 at ST 7175 6896 (point L) and proceeding in a generally WSW direction for approx 149m to a junction with FP BA5/64 at ST 7163 6889 (point M); FP BA5/64 From a junction with FP BA18/29 at ST 7163 6889 (point M) and turning in a generally S direction for approx 31m to ST 7162 6886 (point N) and turning in a generally WSW direction for approx 594m to a junction with FP BA5/54 at ST 7114 6852 (point P); FP BA5/65 From a junction with FP BA5/61 at ST 7269 6824 (point T) and proceeding in a generally NNW direction for approx 294 metres to ST 7254 6850 (point R) and turning in a generally SW direction for approx 86m to ST 7248 6844 (point Q) and turning in a generally WNW direction for approx 730m to a junction with FP BA5/46 at ST 7181 6868 (point E); FP BA5/66 From a junction with FP BA5/61 at ST 7273 6847 (point V) proceeding in a generally NE direction for approx 25m to a junction with Lansdown Road at ST 7275 6849 (point W); as shown on the order map.

2.The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to extinguish the public footpaths (FPs): FP BA5/35 running from grid reference ST 7267 6819 (point F on the Order Map) and proceeding in a generally northerly direction for approximately 385 metres to grid reference ST 7261 6856 (point G on the Order Map); FP BA5/37 running from grid reference ST 7191 6891 (point H on the Order Map) and proceeding in a generally west-northwesterly direction for approximately 139 metres to a junction with FP BA5/43 and FP BA5/45 at grid reference ST 7178 6897 (point A on the Order Map); FP BA5/43 running from grid reference ST 7182 6898 (point J on the Order Map) and proceeding in a generally westerly direction for approximately 41 metres to a junction with FP BA5/45 and FP BA5/37 at grid reference ST 7178 6897 (point A on the Order Map); FP BA5/45 running from a junction with FP BA5/43 and FP BA5/37 at grid reference ST 7178 6897 (point A on the Order Map) and proceeding in a generally westsouthwesterly direction for approximately 137 metres to grid reference ST 7166 6891 (point B on the Order Map) and turning in a generally south-southwesterly

direction for approximately 592 metres to a junction with FP BA5/46 and FP BA5/47 at grid reference ST 7139 6839 (point C on the Order Map); FP BA5/46 running from a junction with FP BA5/36 and FP BA5/37 at grid reference ST 7210 6883 (point D on the Order Map) and proceeding in a generally westsouthwesterly direction for approximately 321 metres to grid reference ST 7181 6868 (point E on the Order Map) as shown on the order map.

Timetable for sending in statements of case and comments

Within 2 weeks of the start date [by 02 March 2021]

The Order Making Authority must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Orders.

Within 8 weeks of the start date [by 13 April 2021]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation or any other written representation must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send full copies to the Authority. Copies (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) will also be sent to the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Orders.

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, Secretary of State will send a full copy to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Orders (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 25 May 2021]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation, the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Orders must ensure that their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies of these comments to everyone else.

Any other person wishing to make representations in writing to the Secretary of State in respect of the above Orders must do so in line with the timetable set out above.

In fairness to the other parties everyone should keep to the timetable to ensure that statements of case and comments are received on time. Late documents will be returned.
