EXTENSION OF EMERGENCY CLOSURE BY NOTICE

SECTION 14(2) OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

PUBLIC BYWAY BA25/33, HASSAGE HILL, WELLOW

Notice is given that the emergency closure brought into force on 23 January 2024 by Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Authority") in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") will be continued for a further 21 days, in accordance with the Authority's powers under section 15(8)(b)(ii) of the Act.

The closure relates to the section of Public Byway BA25/33 commencing from grid reference ST 7325 5604 at a junction with Public Byway BA23/29 and Public Bridleway BA25/49 (Point A on the Notice Plan) and proceeding in a generally easterly direction for approximately 773 metres to grid reference ST 7397 5587 (Point B on the Notice Plan).


This temporary closure is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public, namely the danger caused by a split ash tree that is at risk of falling suddenly onto the byway. This emergency closure will remain in place until 5 March 2024 and may thereafter be extended by an Order made under section 14(1) of the Act.
