TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2022**


Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Council") being the highway authority for in the County and District of Bath and North East Somerset is satisfied that pedestrian traffic over the said footpath should be restricted because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the right of way by the owners of Ashton House, Ashton Hill – namely the demolition of a garage and the reconfiguration of a parking area.

The Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following order:

1. No person shall proceed over that length of Public Footpath BA9/18 commencing from the southwest end of public footpath BA9/18 at grid reference ST 6917 6537 (point A on the Order Plan) and proceeding generally in a north-easterly direction for approximately 172 metres to the junction with The Barton at grid reference ST 6931 6546 (point B on the Order Plan).
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any contractor necessarily proceeding to or from the said works.
3. This order shall come into operation on 3rd October 2022 and will be operative for a period of 11 weeks. The Order may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council (Public Footpath BA9/18, The Barton, Corston) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2022.
