(PUBLIC FOOTPATH BA4/40, CAMERTON AND PUBLIC FOOTPATH BA19/1,
CARLINGCOTT, PEASEDOWN ST JOHN)
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023**

Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Council") being the highway authority for Public Footpaths BA4/40 and BA19/1 in the County and District of Bath and North East Somerset is satisfied that pedestrian traffic in the said public footpaths should be restricted because of the likelihood of danger to the public, namely the danger caused by a broken support on a footbridge which requires replacement before the footpaths can once again be used safely.

The Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following order:

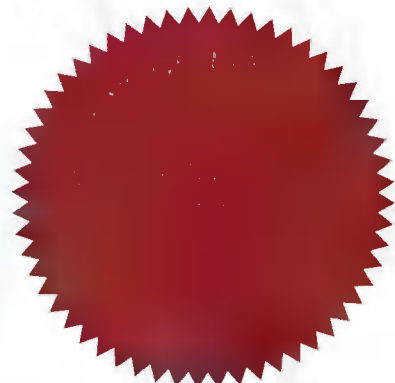
1. No person shall proceed in that length of Public Footpath BA4/40 commencing from a junction with Public Footpath BA4/41 at grid reference ST 6929 5834 (Point A on the Order Plan) and proceeding in a generally south-easterly direction for approximately 102 metres to a junction with Public Footpath BA19/1 at grid reference ST 6936 5828 (Point B on the Order Plan); nor in that length of Public Footpath BA19/1 commencing from a junction with Public Footpath BA4/40 at grid reference ST 6936 5828 (Point B on the Order Plan) and proceeding in a generally south-westerly direction for approximately 64 metres to a junction with Carlingcott at grid reference ST 6933 5825 (Point C on the Order Plan).
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any contractor necessarily proceeding to or from the said works.
3. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any pedestrian requiring access to any premises situated on or adjacent to the Public Footpath, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from, the Public Footpath.
4. This order shall come into operation on 28th September 2023 and will be operative for a period of six months. The Order may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council (Public Footpath BA4/40, Camerton and Public Footpath BA19/1, Peasedown St John) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2023.
