EMERGENCY CLOSURE BY NOTICE

SECTION 14(2) OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 (PUBLIC FOOTPATH BA27/34, STEEL MILLS, KEYNSHAM)

Notice is given that Bath and North East Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has temporarily introduced a path closure with immediate effect on public footpath BA27/34 commencing from a junction with Fairview Terrace at ST 6572 6816 (Point A) and proceeding in a generally southerly direction adjacent to the river for approximately 140 metres to grid reference ST 6570 6803 (Point B).
