

NOTICE OF ORDER

SECTION 14 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH BA1/32, GLASSES CROSSING, BATHAMPTON) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2020

Notice is given that Bath and North East Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has made an order to the effect of which is to temporarily introduce a path closure to the section of public footpath BA1/32 commencing from a junction with Tynning Road in Bathampton and proceeding in a generally northeasterly direction for approximately 45 metres across the railway line at Glasses Crossing to grid reference ST 7824 6664.


This order is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the right of way; namely, Network Rail are proposing to carry out essential rail maintenance works. The Order will come into force on 5th June 2020 and will be effective for up to six months; the closure will only be effective during that period when signs stating 'Path Closed' are in place.
