

NOTICE OF EXTENSION OF AN ORDER

SECTION 14 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS ACT 1984

BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (BC44/11, RALPH ALLEN BUILDING, KINGSMEAD) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2019

Notice is given that the Secretary of State for Transport in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has extended the duration of the above named order which has the effect of temporarily closing public footpath BC44/11, which runs from Milk Street to Avon Street in Kingsmead, Bath.

This extension is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the right of way; namely, McAleer & Rushe Contracts UK are demolishing Ralph Allen building and constructing a new hotel development. The Order has been extended until 7th May 2021.
