

# NOTICE OF MAKING ORDER

## SECTION 14 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS ACT 1984

### BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (BC44/11, RALPH ALLEN BUILDING, KINGSMEAD) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2019


Notice is given that Bath and North East Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has made an order to the effect of which will be to temporarily introduce a path closure to public footpath BC44/11, which runs from Milk Street to Avon Street in Kingsmead, Bath.

This order is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the right of way; namely, McAleer & Rushe Contracts UK are proposing to demolish Ralph Allen building and construct a new hotel development. The Order will come into force on 7th November 2019 and will be effective for six months.
