Notice is given that Bath and North East Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 intends to make an order, the effect of which will be to temporarily introduce a path closure to the lengths of public footpaths from grid reference ST 6900 6664 (point A on the attached map) in a southeasterly direction to grid reference ST 7040 6589 (point D), namely BA27/47 from Saltford Rowing Club to its junction with public footpath BA9/5; the full lengths of BA9/5 and BA9/4; and BA17/3 from its junction with BA9/4 to the point where it passes underneath the Bristol and Bath Railway Path Cycle Track.

This order is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the rights of way; namely, Network Rail are proposing to carry out remedial embankment works. The Order will come into force on 3^{rd} August 2020 and will be effective for a maximum period of 6 months. The restriction may not be effected for the whole of the period but only for so long as is necessary to execute the works. This is anticipated to be for $4\frac{1}{2}$ months.


