SCREENING PROCEDURE: For the following question, 1 standard drink = 1 unit of alcohol.

One standard drink is



Half pint of regular beer, lager or cider



Half a small glass of wine



1 single measure/shot of spirits

The following quantities of alcohol contain more than 1 standard drink

2 UNITS



Pint of regular beer, lager or cider

9 UNITS



750ml bottle of wine

1.5 UNITS



Alcopop or bottle of regular beer or lager

4 UNITS



Can of super strength beer or lager

18 UNITS



2 litre of strong cider

40 UNITS



1 litre of spirits

Scoring the M-SASQ

If the response is 'Monthly', 'Weekly' or 'Daily or almost daily', the score is M-SASQ Positive. If their response is 'Never' or 'Less than monthly', the score is M-SASQ Negative.
