**(VARIOUS ROADS, BATH) (UPPER LANGRIDGE, LANGRIDGE, TADWICK,  
UPPER SWAINSWICK AND WOOLLEY AREAS) (20 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT)  
(30 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2023**

NOTICE is given that on 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2023 the Bath and North East Somerset Council made the following order under provisions contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be that it is prohibited to drive a motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour or 30 miles per hour on the lengths of the road in Bath as listed in the schedule to this notice.

The Bath and North East Somerset Council (Various Roads, Bath) (Upper Langridge, Langridge, Tadwick, Upper Swainswick and Woolley area) (20 M.P.H. Speed Limit) (30 M.P.H. Speed Limit) Order 2023 will come into operation on **3<sup>rd</sup> March 2023** and a copy, together with a map and a Statement of the Council's reasons for making the order may be inspected, free of charge, at The One Stop Shops 3-4 Manvers Street, Bath and at the Keynsham Civic Centre, Market Walk, Keynsham during normal office hours. Any person who desires to question the validity of, or any provision contained in the order on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any of the relevant requirements of that Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, may within six weeks after the date on which the order was made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

**SCHEDULE 1**  
**20 M.P.H. Speed Limit**

<b>Langridge Lane</b>	From a point 30 metres east of its junction with Lansdown Road for a distance of 721 metres in a north easterly direction.
<b>Langridge Lane</b>	That length of Langridge Lane which extends from a point 402 metres west of Tynning Lane in an easterly direction to its junction with Tadwick Lane.
<b>Tynning Lane</b>	Entire length.
<b>Tadwick Lane</b>	From a point 690 metres north of Langridge Lane for a distance of 490 metres in a northerly direction.
<b>Tadwick Lane</b>	That length of Tadwick Lane which extends from a point 565 metres south east of Woolley Lane to its junction with Gloucester Road.
<b>Manor Lane</b>	Entire length.
<b>Church Lane</b>	Entire length.
<b>Innox Lane</b>	Entire length.
<b>Blacksmith Lane</b>	Entire length.
<b>Gloucester Road</b>	That part of Gloucester Road which extends from its junction with Tadwick Lane for a distance of 127 metres in a northerly direction.
<b>Woolley Lane</b>	From a point 210 metres south of its junction with Tadwick Lane to its junction with the High Street.
<b>High Street</b>	Entire length.
<b>Church Street</b>	Entire length.
<b>Woolley Lane</b>	From its junction with the High Street for a distance of 180 metres in a southerly direction.

**SCHEDULE 2**  
**30 M.P.H Speed Limit**

**Langridge Lane**

From a point 751 metres east of its junction with Lansdown Road for a distance of 805 metres in a north easterly direction.

**Tadwick Lane**

That length of Tadwick Lane which extends from a point 690 metres north of Langridge Lane for a distance of 2,780 metres in a southerly direction.

**Woolley Lane**

From its junction with Tadwick Lane for a distance of 210 metres in a southerly direction.

**Woolley Lane**

From a point 180 metres south of its junction with the High Street to its junction with Charcombe Lane.
