(VARIATION NO .1) ORDER 2022

NOTICE is given that on **10th March 2022** the Bath and North East Somerset Council made the above order, under provisions contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will remove Hallatrow Road from Schedule 2 of that order.

The Bath and North East Somerset Council (Various Roads, Paulton) (20 M.P.H Speed limit) (30 M.P.H Speed Limit) (Variation NO.1) Order 2022 will come into operation on **14th March 2022**. Any person who desires to question the validity of, or any provision contained in the order on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any of the relevant requirements of that Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, may within six weeks after the date on which the order was made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
